2020 Ford Explorer Loss in Value Case Study

It was the Ford Explorer that led to an increase in SUV sales in the early 1990s, and the 2020 model offers a wealth of useful features and popular content. The 2020 Ford Explorer represents a complete rethink of a three-row family SUV, now entering its sixth generation. As opposed to early Explorers that were built on truck frames and driven primarily by the rear wheels, the outgoing Explorer employs front-wheel drive and has a car-like unibody.

Although the new 2020 Ford Explorer offers much better rides, handles, and accommodations than the model it replaces, it doesn't score a grand slam. It is also dynamically superior to its crossover competitors. The hybrid offers unexpected benefits that extend beyond fuel economy, too. But the interior materials don't quite match the price. Overall, the Explorer is an excellent choice.

It is estimated that the 2.3-liter EcoBoost engine in the Base, XLT, and Limited models returns slightly better fuel economy than its closest competition. Rear-wheel-drive

models are EPA-rated at 24 mpg combined, while all-wheel-drive models are rated at 23 mpg combined. Depending on what you compare it to, it usually gets one or two extra miles per gallon.

Every Explorer comes with an 8-inch touchscreen, the Sync 3 infotainment system, and support for Apple CarPlay and Android Auto. There is a built-in navigation system and an excellent Bang & Olufsen premium audio system. Avoid the 10.1-inch vertical touchscreen, as its slimmer profile interferes with Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, and the rearview camera display.
