The 2021 Ram 1500 stands out amongst its peers not just because of its "best-in-class" accolades, but due to its dedication to the concept of elevated expectations for the entire pickup truck breed. No longer are pickups judged based solely on their

ruggedness; this latest Ram offers a luxurious interior, comfortable ride quality, and plenty of options that you won't find from competitors like the Chevy Silverado 1500, GMC Sierra 1500, and Ford F-150. The Ram improves upon these features with an air suspension system, built-in cargo bed bins, split-folding tailgate, and a giant 12.0-inch touchscreen. Its diesel six-cylinder engine adds excellent fuel efficiency and ample torque too. Alongside its standard V6 and optional Hemi V8 engines, hybrid



systems contribute to Ram's contemporary feel, which is further enhanced by its indepth technologies and wide range of capabilities.

In addition to its many trim levels, the Ram 1500 has gasoline powertrains with V-6 and V-8 engines paired with an eight-speed automatic transmission that shifts smoothly. Rear suspensions on Ram 1500s are standard coil springs or optional air springs, unlike leaf springs on domestic competitors. Light steering and strong brakes provide a comfortable ride as well as confident stopping.

As a result, the EPA estimates that the most efficient V-6 Ram would earn up to 20 mpg in the city and 26 mpg on the highway, while the V-8 Ram will get up to 17 mpg in the city and 23 mpg on the highway. The government estimates diesel-powered Rams would earn up to 22 mpg in the city and 32 mpg on the highway;
