Depreciation table for the top 5 used sedans sold in the US.

As a percentage of its current value, the Toyota Camry ties with the Nissan Altima for having the highest residual value after 5 years. However, the Altima has a higher cost of ownership making the Toyota Camry the king of used sedans in the US.
