Its spacious 526-liter boot capacity also outshines competitors, making it a practical and cutting-edge choice in the electric SUV segment.

BMW 5 Series



The BMW 5-series, a perfect balance between the spacious 7-series and the compact 3-series, is set to continue its legacy with its upcoming generation. This new model promises a luxurious and roomy cabin, enhanced by BMW's latest iDrive 8.5 digital dashboard. It also features an available hands-free driver-assistance system. Cadillac Electric Escalade



The Cadillac Escalade, renowned for its opulence, is gearing up for an electric revolution with the Escalade IQ. Launching in summer 2024, this 750-hp behemoth is Cadillac's answer to the growing demand for eco-friendly luxury. Ditching the traditional gas-guzzling V-8 for a cleaner, more powerful electric engine, the Escalade IQ aims for a remarkable 450-mile range. This move not only elevates Cadillac's environmental credentials but also positions the Escalade IQ as a frontrunner in the electric SUV arena, offering unmatched range and luxury.

Chevrolet Blazer EV



The 2024 Chevrolet Blazer EV marks Chevy's bold entry into electric vehicles, transforming the classic Blazer into a dynamic electric crossover. Its SS trim stands out with 557 horsepower and rapid acceleration to 60 mph in under four seconds, challenging rivals like the Ford Mustang Mach-E GT and Tesla Model Y Performance. Featuring GM's Ultium battery technology, the Blazer EV offers various trims, with the RS model boasting an impressive 324-mile range, blending performance with practicality in the electric SUV segment.

Fisker Ocean



The 2024 Fisker Ocean stands out as one of the best cars for 2024 in the electric SUV market with its striking design and impressive 360-mile range. This newcomer from Fisker offers zippy acceleration and balanced handling, outperforming rivals like the Cadillac Lyriq and Genesis Electrified GV70 in range. Its eco-friendly interior, using recycled ocean plastics, adds to its appeal. Choosing the Fisker Ocean is a leap of faith into a new brand, promising a stylish and sustainable driving experience.

Ford Ranger



The 2024 Ford Ranger gets a bold redesign, featuring F-150-inspired styling. It sticks with the 2.3-liter four-cylinder engine but introduces a more powerful twin-turbo V-6 option, available in both rear- and four-wheel drive. The Ranger Raptor variant brings high performance but is reviewed separately.

This year, it's exclusively offered as a crew cab with four full-size doors. Inside, it adopts a new infotainment system similar to the Edge SUV's high-end models. Competing with rivals like the Chevrolet Colorado, GMC Canyon, and Toyota Tacoma, the 2024 Ranger brings fresh competition to the mid-size pickup truck segment.

Honda Prologue



The 2024 Honda Prologue SUV is Honda's second electric vehicle, sharing a platform with GM. It offers a single-motor option with 212 horsepower and an all-wheel-drive choice with 288 horsepower. Front-wheel drive models provide up to 296 miles of range, while all-wheel drive drops it to around 273 miles. Positioned above the CR-V, the Prologue features a sleek design and a modern interior with a tablet-style infotainment display. Honda's luxury brand, Acura, will soon introduce the ZDX EV SUV with enhanced luxury and power.

Hyundai Ioniq 5 N

Hyundai is introducing the Ioniq 5 N, a high-performance version of the acclaimed electric Ioniq 5. With 601 horsepower and a temporary boost to 641 ponies, thanks to the N Grin Boost feature, it promises an exhilarating driving experience. Tuned by Hyundai's N division, it offers unique performance enhancements, including sportier design elements like a rear diffuser, larger wheels, and wider fenders. Anticipation is building for this thrilling electric SUV.

Kia EV9



The all-electric EV9 SUV, considered one of the best cars for 2024, sized similarly to the Telluride, shares its platform with the Hyundai Ioniq 7. It's available in rear- or all-wheel drive, with the latter packing a 379-hp dual-motor setup. Both Long Range models offer a 304-mile range with a 99.8-kWh battery. The standard rear-wheel-drive EV9 boasts a 230-mile range with a 76.1-kWh battery. Despite its size, it can tow up to 5000 pounds, like the gas Telluride. With three rows of seats and a sub-\$60k starting price, it's an exceptional choice among large EVs.

Lucid Gravity



Lucid Motors introduces the 2025 Gravity SUV, featuring two electric motors for all-wheel drive and an estimated range exceeding 440 miles per charge for top models. It offers two- and three-row configurations, combining luxury and tech with a striking 34-inch curved digital display screen. Competing with established EV SUVs like the Audi Q8 e-tron, Cadillac Lyriq, Jaguar I-Pace, and Tesla Model X, Gravity stands out with its impressive range and features.

Tesla Model 3 Highland



The new Tesla Model 3 Highland is available on Tesla's website, priced from \$40,630 for the base "Model 3" and \$51,130 for the Long Range model, including fees. Range varies; the base rear-wheel-drive Model 3 offers 272 miles on smaller wheels and 248 miles on larger ones. The Long Range Model 3 achieves 341 miles on smaller wheels and 305 miles on larger ones.

Although the Model 3 Performance isn't currently available, it's expected later. The Model 3 Highland features significant design updates, including a minimalist interior with controls on the screen and steering wheel. Other changes include improved sound insulation, new suspension mounting points, softer springs, acoustically insulated glass, and enhanced brake hardware, while the powertrain remains unchanged.

Toyota Camry



The Toyota Camry, a hidden gem among the best cars for 2024, is a longstanding institution in the sedan world, known for over two decades as the best-selling sedan in the U.S. It offers a 301-hp V-6 option and a fuel-efficient hybrid four-cylinder, setting it apart from rivals. The current generation combines reliability with stylish design, especially with the Nightshade package's appealing bronze wheels. Despite sportier variants, it remains unmistakably a Camry.
